Coffee Industry Corporation *

The Coffee Industry Corporation (CIC) is a government body regulating coffee and supporting the coffee industry's development PNG.

CIC manages the buying and selling of coffee, sets prices, and monitors the regulatory aspects of coffee export. Its functions include registering coffee exporters and processing facilities, carrying out quality control and export controls, and promoting the sale and consumption of PNG coffee at home and abroad.



Nowek Coffee 🐐

Nowek Coffee is a family-owned and operated coffee company located in the highlands of PNG. The company was established in the 1980s and has a wet and dry mill. Nowek exports quality arabica coffee sourced from local communities in the highlands of PNG. Nowek believes in long-term benefits of sustainable practices. It works closely with local coffee communities to educate and support them to earn income sustainably.



Kongo Coffee 🐐

Kongo Coffee is located in Simbu Province in the highlands of PNG. It is one of the locally owned coffee exporting companies in PNG. Kongo coffee has been growing, buying, processing and roasting coffee for the export and local market for the past 20 years. Kongo exports an average of 4,000 tons of high-quality green beans annually to different international destinations, including Germany, Japan, the US, the UK, Australia, South Korea and Taiwan.



Banz Coffee 🐐

Banz Coffee is a single-origin coffee sourced from local community farmers in the Whagi valley of PNG's Western Highlands Province.

High-quality coffee beans are processed, roasted, and packed on-site at the Banz Kofi factory at Mount Hagen. Banz Kofi is highly community-focused and production is interlinked with engagement with the local community.

Cateco Trading 🐔

Cateco trading is an Australian-based importer and distributor of specialty coffee and cocoa beans from PNG and Southeast Asia. It supplies specialty processed coffee beans and certified, organic and honey-processed coffee as per customers' requirements. PNG coffee beans are traditionally the fully washed arabica- typica variety, most originating above 1,200-1,300 meters. Cateco works with farmer groups to bring their unique coffees to the market.
